The juniors have done a fantastic job of recruiting their friends etc, and it is now up to the senior players to try and do the same and re-generate the playing numbers. I also believe we need greater ownership of the club from the senior playing group, get involved with your mates and make Templeton the place you want it to be. JUNIOR SEASON REPORT

For the juniors we had a pretty good 10/11 season with 3 out of the 4 teams we fielded making finals and our top 16 side winning a flag. Our mix of teams this year was a little different from last few years with only one U12 and one U14 but two U16 teams.

Our 12's graded in 12-2 were mainly first year players and with the great coaching of Paul Williams and the team management of Sean Meehan made it through to the semis where they were just beaten. It was a great effort for the boys most of which will hopefully be back next season. Zack Barmby again dominated topping all the team stats and also taking the 12-2 comp bowling.

The 14's started in 14-2 and were regraded to 14-1. We were a little concerned initially with quite a few first year players in the side. Steve Dewar did a fantastic job working with boys and with the help of team manager Craig Henry they really developed the team and in the end the boys proved that our concerns were unfounded making it through to the semis where they were beaten by only 3 runs. There were certainly a number of highlights throughout the season. Jack Pollard carrying his bat in the T20 round finishing the day 71 not out and winning the team all rounder. Liam Pemberton a first year player winning the team bowling and the comp encouragement award. Lincoln Wong winning the team and comp batting. Lincoln and Polly putting on a 120 1st wicket stand in the T20. We also had three players pick in the VMCU U14 Des Nolan side, Josh Hudson, Lincoln Wong and Eranga Ruwadeniya. They went on to win the comp and Huddo was named player of the tournament for the team. Five of the boys, Tyson Henry, Lincoln Wong, Josh Hudson, Jack Pollard and Josh Barmby also played seniors in the with Josh Barmby taking the 5's bowling for season.

We had about 18 players for the 16's so we accepted an offer to do a combined side with Heathmont Baptist for our second side. Heathmont sent a few players down and they seemed to fit in quite well, after having a look at the boys we decided to play one of the boys Ben Grechko in our top side. The combined side were graded in the 16-4's and were in the hunt for finals right up to the last round and finished the season in 5th place. Wayne Guest took on the coaching role and had the help of Colleen Sedgman from Heathmont Baptist who took on the Team Manager role. Ryan Gill won the batting and all rounder for the team with Tom Green from Heathmont taking the bowling. We ended up with being just a few short to field two full sides in the 16's but fortunately the 14's had 15 so we were able to give the boys who may have had to sit out a week a chance to play in our second 16 side. This also meant we were able to rotate some of the 16 between the teams to give a few of the guys a chance to play in a higher grade.

Our top 16's were graded in 16-2 and had a great season. Coached by Paul 'PT' Taylor the boys the boys worked hard to develop their skills to win the games and other challenges PT threw at them. The end result was going through the season undefeated and winning the flag. Looking back over the season every player performed and really made the season a team effort. The team awards were Jordan Roberts winning bowling and all rounder with Luke Molyneux winning the batting. Eight of the team earned spots on senior sides from as high as the 2's through to the 4's. We also had three

of the boys picked in rep sides with Luke Molyneux and Matthew Petherick playing for the RDCA U16 Jim Bietzel Shield. Jordan Roberts in the Bayswater Hatch side.

Our junior program is developing some very talented players who will hopefully go on to be solid senior players and help the club to continue to be a very strong club.

DIRECTOR OF FINANCE REPORT SEASON 2010/2011

The goal for the Templeton Cricket Club in season 2010/2011 was to ensure that the club progressed on and off the field during the season.

We have priorities to increase the Bank account balance each season to a level where we can look at long-term projects to improve our clubrooms. But this goal was made hard this season with the lack of playing numbers and attendances at the club on Saturdays and at club functions.

Financially, we recorded a profit of \$12003, which is an increase of \$9036 from last season's profit with our Bank account balance ending the year at \$24621.

The highlights for the season were the following:

1. A highly successful Superdraw function that made a profit of \$10539 on the day, which is another amazing result. Thank you to Jason Disney and Brett Keys for another fantastic effort.
2. The canteen made a very good profit of \$2094. An excellent effort by Dot and Ian Roberts in running the canteen for the year.
3. Sponsorship money stayed at the same level as last season which is great. Thank you to all of our sponsors for their generous support.
4. Bunnings Barbeques are an excellent fundraiser for the club and we made a profit of \$2510 with them this year.

Notes

We fixed and serviced the lines and other parts at a cost of \$1141 to allow the kegs to be used effectively.

There is an outstanding invoice of \$911 which relates to the insurance for our players which we never received an invoice from the RDCA. This will be paid next season.

NOTES FORMING PART OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

INCOME

BAR

A decrease in income of \$5296 from last season, which means that our Bar income has dropped \$11547 in the past 2 seasons. Our level of income in this area used to sit between \$30k - \$33k each year and obviously this can't be relied upon to support the clubs finances. We maintained our prices this season and we used the kegs as often as possible. Thanks to Tyson McCamley for his assistance as the bar manager.

CANTEEN

A lot of hard work by Dot and Ian Roberts resulted in a profit of \$2094 which was a increase of \$526 from last season. The canteen figures are distorted slightly as Craig had one float for the season for convenience purposes and the dinners are included in here.

CLUB MERCHANDISE

The total dollar value of clothing sold was \$450, which was an decrease of \$7302 from last season as last season we new cricket shirts and the 20/20 shirts.

SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

We only had a few social functions for the season with the attendances being mainly from the same people at all events. Thanks to those who helped with the organization of our functions.

AFTERNOON TEA

We made a profit of \$55 for the season which was good. Thank you to Mrs Garvey for her efforts as well as Ian and Craig for making the afternoon teas this season. We slightly changed the food but with minimal difference in the standard of the food and at a better cost saving.

DINNERS

We raised \$210 this season which was a drop of income of \$1156 with a loss of \$429. These figures are slightly distorted as some of the income is in the canteen revenue. Thanks to Craig Henry for all of his hard work. This result highlights the lack of numbers on Thursday and Saturday nights and most of the time the meals were costed to break even.

BUNNINGS BARBEQUE

We conducted a Senior and Junior Bunnings Barbecue day during the season which raised us \$3088 and a profit of \$2510.

RAFFLES

We only raised \$80 this season as numbers were down at the club.

PRE SEASON RAFFLE

No Pre season raffle was conducted this year.

SPONSORSHIP

Thank you to all of our sponsors especially SPAusnet as our major sponsor for this season as well as Andrew Morris at CHN Herold Ross Chartered Accountants, Simon Denton at Port Melbourne Containers, Knox Tavern and Val U Vouchers, Discount Meat Outlets and Bakers Delight in Vermont South.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

There was a increase in subscriptions of \$2958 from last season which was back to the same level of 2 seasons ago. This increase has occurred due to more senior players at the club, a better collection method and the Ezi deddit option.

INTEREST

There was an increase of \$1 from last season.

EXPENSES

CRICKET BALLS

The expenditure decreased by \$1314 this season. This as a high expense item and we need to keep this under control and over the last 2 seasons this expense has dropped \$2825.

COACHING

This amount consists of payments to our coach and paid players. This amount increased by \$1496 from last season.

EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT

We purchased no cricket equipment this season.

GROUND FEES

There was a decrease in the fees of \$147 this season.

RDCA

This seasons costs decreased by \$332 from the previous season.

INDOOR TRAINING

An increase in expenditure of \$550 from last season with a loss of \$2062 overall. This was an increased loss of \$728 from last season as less players trained this indoor this pre-season.

UMPIRES - FINALS

No senior finals this season.

BAR

Expenditure decreased by \$29 for the season.

SLURPEE

The cost of the slurpee mix increased this season by \$474.

CLUB MERCHANDISE

A large decrease of \$10626 this season as last season we spent \$9465 on our new cricket shirts and 20/20 shirts. This season we will need to organise new cricket shirts.

AUCTION

Auction expenses this season were allocated to the superdraw function.

SOCIAL/FUNDRAISING

This includes payments for functions during the year and all other expenses incurred in presenting functions for the players.

CLEANING

A decrease in costs of \$453 this season. Thanks to Mal Calladine and Ian & Dot Roberts for their efforts. The clubrooms displayed a professional image to our members and visitors at all times. This season also included the cleaning of Milpera Reserve.

LIQUOR LICENCE

Due to the lack of applications to vary our hours the costs were down by \$283.

TELEPHONE

There was a decrease in expenditure of \$109 from last season.

INSURANCE

We didn't receive an invoice this season due to a misunderstanding between us and the RDCA. An amount of \$911 will be paid in next season's accounts.

FINES

This season our fines from the RDCA were down to \$120 from last season's \$225. Well done to everyone concerned. The goal is for no fines next year.

TROPHIES

A decrease in expenditure of \$964 this season with both Senior and Junior costs coming down. The reason was a lack of players qualifying for their team's awards and no Senior premierships.

BANK CHARGES

The credit /debit card merchant facility accrued charges of \$612 an increase of \$2 from the previous season. With the Eftpos machine we had credit / debit card spending of \$22113 up \$5407 from last season. There were 169 electronic card transactions this season well up on last season's 80 but not as high as our record of 242.

STATIONERY

There was an increase in costs of \$53 this season.

INTERNET

A decrease of \$715 from last season as we no longer need to have internet access at the clubrooms. This amount will be further reduced next season.

WEBSITE

The cost of the maintenance of the website increased by \$65 this season.

Captains Report 2nd XI

SEASON REPORT

Our top 16's were graded in the 16-2's (John Springett Shield) for the 10-11 season and we were pretty confident of a good season. The core of the team which included Luke Molyneux, Jayden Bennet, Jordan Roberts, Scott Lawson, Matthew Petherick and Dushan Ranasinghe had played together two years earlier winning a flag in the 14-2's and Nick Adam who's bowling had impressed during the pre season. We also had a few new players join us, Ryan Sweeten from Bayswater Park, Hamandip Sahota from Wantirna South and Ben Gechko who was originally going to play in our second 16's as part of a combined side with Heathmont Baptist. We also set aside some spots to allow us to give players from our second side the chance to play up in the higher grade.

Round 1 v South Warrandyte. Nice start to the season with our batting, with Mazz (27) and Ryan (29) proving to be a good opening pair putting on 63 for the first wicket. Luke (34) and Jordan (44) putting on an 82 run stand for the 3rd wicket. Our bowling was solid but with a few too many extras, the main highlight being Ryan's 7/12, he missed a hat trick but did take 3/0 at one stage. Round 2 v Ainslie. Both weeks washed out

Round 3 v Wantirna South. Lost the toss and Wantirna South batted . Our bowling depth was shown in this game with 8 bowlers used, 6 taking wickets. The pick of the bowlers were Jordan 11 overs 2/27 and Ryan 8 overs 2/24. Still a few too many extras but improving. Wantirna South 8/157 (cc). SEASON REPORT

At the start of the season, we were graded in the under 14 second division. Given the number of players coming up from the under 12s and first time cricketers, we felt that this was the best division for the boys. With 15 players in the squad it was always going to be difficult to create a roster allowing everyone the opportunity to play cricket. Thankfully the second under 16s side was short of numbers most weeks, allowing a couple of under 14s the opportunity to play cricket instead of missing out. The boys took this opportunity, posting impressive performances with both bat and ball and showing improvement in their cricket.

Round 1 was played against Sth Croydon and the boys having a convincing 70 run win, on the back of a great team bowling effort and a well compiled 52 by Jack P. With a washout in round 2, the RDCA decided to move the team up to 14/1s, initially to our disappointment. Over the course of the season however the boys proved us wrong, constantly winning games. They finished the year second on the ladder, with 6 wins, two washouts and two losses. Before talking about the finals campaign I want to quickly mention some of the seasons highlights from the home and away rounds. In round 3, the game was starting to get away from us when Luke Philpott came on, taking two crucial wickets. This enabled us to bowl them out for 133 and in the following week, Lincoln Wong and Jack Pollard both battered superbly, posting 50 retired and 44 respectively. In round 5 it was Josh Hudson and Josh Barmby who batted sensibly after the loss of early wickets to give us a defendable total of 98 in a 30 over a side match. Liam Pemberton in his first season of cricket produced a high quality spell of bowling to end up with the figures of 5/20 off 5 overs. Round 7 was the designated 20/20 round, with Jack Pollard and Lincoln Wong dominating the Croydon Ranges attack posting 71 and 42 respectively. Round 8 it was once again Liam Pemberton who was the hero, taking 6/22 off 7 overs in a clinical leg spin bowling performance. Round 9 was our most disappointing loss of the season, with only Lincoln Wong scoring over 15 with the bat in our run chase. He posted 61 in a lone hand, while the previous week our bowlers had performed very well as a unit, with Noah Jackson taking 3 for 13 and Jack Adam bowling very economically with 1/5 off 5. The final game of the season was

against our eventual semi final opponent in Mooroolbark. This game was certainly the best team performance that we had all season, especially the way in which we fielded. It was probably the first time when the boys showed true desperation in the field, and it was rewarded with a run out and some impressive catching, especially from Luke Philpott for the final wicket. We ended up bowling them out for 120 in response to our 139 with Jake Middleton proving his worth with his best spell of the year taking 2/25 off 10. With the bat Lincoln once again retired, however contributions from Josh Barmby and Lucas Tzilantonis helped make that total possible.

Our semi final opponent was Mooroolbark again and the game started off well as we won the toss and batted. The steady loss of wickets throughout the day meant that we never really had the opportunity to grab the ascendancy at any stage, and if it weren't for the effort of Jack Pollards 50 we wouldn't have been in the game at all. In the end a score of 125 was compiled on a slow Schultz outfield, and give the previous weeks result we felt as though we were still a great chance. We took out first wicket when the score was 76 with the game looking like it was slipping away. However three more quick wickets fell to put the game back in the balance. Unfortunately our fielding was the component of our game that let us down, with numerous chances being put down at crucial junctures of the game. The boys didn't go down without a fight however, never conceding defeat and ended up taking the game to the final over where we eventually lost by 3 runs.

The finals campaign will enable the boys to become better cricketers, as they will definitely learn from their experiences. Hopefully the loss provides them with motivation to go that extra step further and make it to a grand final, where anything is possible. Throughout the season it was really pleasing to see the improvement of the group across the board in different facets of the game. With three kids who had never played cricket before the season began, to all be contributing to the team's success is a credit to their improvement. Each of the boys has a big future in cricket if they put their mind to it and continue to work hard at improving their game, and hopefully they are all back again next year. From my point of view it was really enjoyable to coach such a likable group of kids, who I'm sure will form part of the future Templeton premiership sides in all grades. I would like to thank all of the parents who helped out at various stages through the year, it certainly made my job a lot easier when there was that support network behind me. In particular, Craig Henry and Dale Hudson for all their work at trainings, on match days and just general advice and tips throughout the year. Go Temps !
