Templeton Cricket Club Director Of Finance Report – 2009/2010

The goal for the Templeton Cricket Club in season 2009/2010 was to ensure that the club progressed on and off the field during the season.

We have priorities to increase the Bank account balance each season to a level where we can look at long-term projects to improve our clubrooms. But this goal was made hard this season with the lack of playing numbers and attendances at the club on Saturdays and at club functions.

Financially, we recorded a profit of \$2973, which is a decrease of \$3480 from last season's profit with our Bank account balance ending the year at \$14261.

The highlights for the season were the following:

- 1. A highly successful Superdraw function that made a profit of \$7166 on the day, which is another amazing result. Thank you to Jason Disney and Brett Keys for another fantastic effort.
- 2. The canteen made a very good profit of \$1568. An excellent effort by Brett and Taylah Keys in running the canteen for the year.
- 3. Sponsorship increased this season to \$9610. Thank you to all of our sponsors especially SPAusnet for their generous support.
- 4. Bunnings Barbeques are an excellent fundraiser for the club and we made a profit of \$968 with them this year.

Notes

We purchased a new Slurpee machine this season at an expense of \$2832. This has already been a great hit for the juniors and seniors on Saturdays or at social functions.

We also went halves with the football club at a cost of \$3350 and purchased a new Fridge for the bar. I would expect our drinks to stay cold all season now.

Further funds were received tottaling \$655 after I closed the accounts for this financial year. These funds will appear in next years accounts.

We also improved the condition of the nets at Templeton at a cost of \$1529.

Notes Forming Part Of Financial Statements

INCOME

BAR

A decrease in income of \$6251 from last season was close to our poor result of 2 seasons ago. Our level of income in this area should sit between \$30k - \$33k each year and obviously can't be relied upon to support the clubs finances. We maintained our prices this season as much as we could but we rarely used kegs. Thanks to Paul Denton for his assistance for the majority of the season.

CANTEEN

A lot of hard work by Brett and Taylah Keys resulted in a profit of \$1568 which was a decrease of \$863 from last season. To enable the canteen to be open each week we paid Taylah \$50 a week for when she worked. This has contributed to the drop in profit this year.

CLUB MERCHANDISE

The total dollar value of clothing sold was \$7752, which was an increase of \$5554 from last season. This includes the new cricket shirts and the 20/20 shirts.

SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

We only had a few social functions for the season with the attendances being mainly from the same people at all events. Thanks to those who helped with the organization of our functions.

AFTERNOON TEA

We made a profit of \$101 for the season which was good. Thank you to Anne Gottliebsen, Brett Keys and other helpers for making the afternoon teas this season. We slightly changed the food but with minimal difference in the standard of the food and at a better cost saving.

DINNERS

We raised \$1156 this season which was a drop of income of \$2604 with a profit of \$637 a big drop from last seasons profit of \$2491. Thanks to Craig Henry for all of his hard work. This highlights the lack of numbers on Thursday and Saturday nights where we purchased pizzas instead of cooking.

BUNNINGS BARBEQUE

We conducted a Senior and Junior Bunnings Barbecue day during the season which raised us \$2047 and a profit of \$763.

RAFFLES

An increase of \$80 from last seasons result but well down from the \$1190 of 3 seasons ago.

PRE SEASON RAFFLE

No Pre season raffle was conducted this year.

SPONSORSHIP

Thank you to all of our sponsors especially SPAusnet as our major sponsor for this season as well as Andrew Morris at CHN Herold Ross Chartered Accountants, Simon Denton at Port Melbourne Containers , KR Peters Real Estate , Knox Tavern and Val U Vouchers.

GRANT

We received one grant this season of \$1000 which we plan to use for future air conditioning of the clubrooms.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

There was a decrease in subscriptions of \$2560 from last season which was caused by the lack of senior players at the club. There was also a number of players who only played 2 or 3 games for the season.

INTEREST

A decrease of \$53 from last season.

EXPENSES

CRICKET BALLS

Expenditure decreased by \$1511 this season. We identified this as a high expense item last season and we needed to keep this under control. Thanks to Leigh Boyle for doing an excellent job this year.

COACHING

This amount consists of payments to our coach and paid players. This amount decreased by \$4379 from last season. This was due to the changing of some senior players in the firsts.

EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT

The purchase/ renewal of equipment is an ongoing expense in running a cricket club. This amount was lower this season by \$842 as we purchased more gear the previous season.

GROUND FEES

An increase in fees of \$320 this season due to the full use of Schultz Reserve this season.

RDCA

This seasons costs increased by \$246 from the previous season.

INDOOR TRAINING

A decrease in expenditure of \$20 from last season with a loss of \$1334 overall. This was an improvement overall of \$694 from last season due to the better collection and payment of training money.

UMPIRES - FINALS

A decrease of \$270 this season.

BAR

Expenditure decreased by \$2771 for the season, which was in comparison to the decrease in income as well. The major reason for the decrease in expenditure was the lack of numbers around the club during the season. Beer gas costs were down by \$129 due to the limited use of the beer taps. This will change next season were we will use them more.

CLUB MERCHANDISE

A large increase of \$8095 this season as we spent \$9465 on our new cricket shirts and 20/20 shirts. This was offset to some degree by the increase in income. We still have some stock on hand.

CORDIAL

Was a very similar cost to last season.

AUCTION

Auction expenses this season were allocated to the superdraw function.

SOCIAL/FUNDRAISING

This includes payments for functions during the year and all other expenses incurred in presenting functions for the players.

BUSHFIRE DONATIONS

There was no donations this season. The previous season we had donations of \$3879 including \$1000 was from the Cricket Club.

CLEANING

An increase in costs of \$479 this season. Thanks to Paul and Judy Denton for their efforts and for Mal Calladine's work after Christmas. The clubrooms displayed a professional image to our members and visitors at all times. This season also included the cleaning of Milpera Reserve.

TELEPHONE

A decrease in expenditure of \$64 from last season.

INSURANCE

An increase of \$17 this season.

FINES

This season our fines from the RDCA were up to \$345 from last seasons \$230. This was due to the forfeiting of the 6ths team on a few occassions as well as the late lodgement of short and full match results. We need to reduce this amount next season with nominated people to lodge theses results each week.

TROPHIES

A decrease in expenditure of \$674 this season with both Senior and Junior costs coming down.

BANK CHARGES

The credit /debit card merchant facility accrued charges of \$610 an increase of \$26 from the previous season. With the Eftpos machine we had credit / debit card spending of \$16706 down \$288 from last season. This was still high because the SPAusnet sponsorship of \$5000 was paid by credit card. There were 80 electronic card transactions this season well down on last seasons 242.

STATIONERY

A decrease in costs of \$144 this season.

INTERNET

An increase of \$918 from last season as we now have an unlimited use Business plan with Telstra for our computer and laptop. This plan will be reviewed next season.

WEBSITE

The cost of the maintenance of the website decreased by \$65 this season.

Junior Operations Report – 2009/2010

For the 09/10 season we again fielded 5 teams. 2 under 12 sides, 2 Under 14's and a under 16 side.
