TCC Annual Report - Coaches Report 2019/20

It is with much pride and excitement that I write this report after finishing my first year as Coach of the senior division.

As both an individual, and a club, we walked into the 2019/20 season with a clear set of objectives. These objectives were not all on-field performance focussed, they were equally weighed up with cultural and club community goals... and I would like to think that as an organisation we achieved most, if not all, of these targets.

Focussing on our performance within club culture and values first, this season saw us create, implement and live up to our clubs newly designed values of RESPECT, COMMITMENT, ENJOYMENT, INCLUSIVE & ACCOUNTABLE TO STANDARDS.

By living by these values, we saw many off-field achievements and improvements met by the group... some of which are below:

- Club attendance at Thursday selection nights, and Saturday after match attendance steadily improved throughout the season, supported by the implementation of rostering where all teams shared the responsibility of coordinating meals
- Club functions were well attended, with our raffle day again being a highlight – but our updated “vote count” night was also very well supported by all members.

- Whole club support across all divisions saw many fans watching T20s for both Veterans and our 1stXI, and many past players continually coming down to support our seniors on a Saturday.

Of equal importance to me was our on-field targets for the season, with a focus on not only winning our first senior premiership in 5 seasons, but also the integration of our young group throughout all grades and helping them understand the “Taipan Way”.

A small selection of our on-field achievements are listed below:

- Wilkins PSV T20 Premiers
- Wilkins Cup Premiers
- 2nd & 3rd XI both finished third
- We had three 1st XI debutants this season, with Coady Mitrevski, Daniel Meehan and Heath Disney all making their debuts, with Dan being what we believe to be our youngest ever 1stXI player at the age of 14
- We fielded our youngest ever 1st XI team on December 14th 2019 against Norwood, with our oldest player in the team being only 23!
- Our 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th XI's all played most of the season having more U18 players in their teams than players over 18 – and very rarely were these teams outclassed by their oppositions.
- Player attendance at training on a Thursday night was always high, and the ability to expose all players across all grades positively impacted many players' performances on a Saturday

I am fully aware that all of our achievements in 2019/20 were prefaced by many years of hard work building up to this point – and I sincerely thank Paul Taylor and the senior committee's past, Sean Meehan and the junior committee's past, and also Adam Slack for his multiple years with the group building the club to this point in our history.

It is an obvious statement to make that our season did not finish in the manner that we wished due to us not being able to play our Grand Final due to the impacts of COVID-19, but that aside no-one can take away the fact that our 1stXI have been promoted to Trollope for season 2020/21.

I strongly believe that we were the best team in the grade, so the Premiership and promotion is thoroughly deserved, and this is supported by the fact that we lost only one match across all formats for the season in this grade.

The upcoming season will provide us with new challenges and targets, and I look forward to not only seeing how our 1stXI group performs in our return to the top grade, but also will watch on with interest on the continued improvement of our young cricketers, and the impact that this development will make on our performances and depth across all grades.

After being fortunate enough to be re-appointed for the next two seasons, I can't wait to keep working with all Taipans as we continue to build our culture on and off the field until we become the best version of Templeton that we can become and this will be supported by a continued focus on club culture and values to support this.

I would like to finish by thanking our 2019/20 Senior Committee, all club captains, players, and members for your unwavering support last season. Without this support, there is no way we could have had the on-field and off-field success that we were able to achieve.
